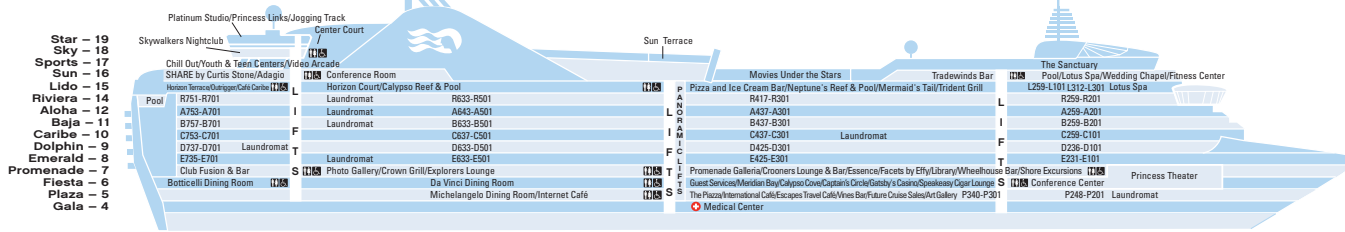

- Note: Some areas of the ship are not accessible to wheelchairs and scooters. Distances shown are from the bow (forward) to stern (aft) to the nearest stateroom. Stateroom views are considered unobstructed unless noted otherwise. Obstructions do not include certain nautical items like handrails, dividers or ship hardware. For balcony staterooms, the view is determined from the perspective of the balcony railing. Balconies may have either solid steel or toughened glass railing.
