Get your wheels moving on a fantastic 17-day e-bike and cruise adventure via Central Europe's scenic waterways, rural countryside and old towns. Start in the picturesque Prague, and travel by e-bike and coach through the Czech Republic to Passau in Germany, where you'll river cruise along the Danube in Austria, Slovakia and Hungary and enjoy three off-the-ship bike rides, before finishing with a tour and ride in Munich led by your local bike guide. The tour meanders its way past medieval villages and castles perched on the hillside and hugs the mighty Danube River, ticking off the main sights of Vienna, Prague, Český Krumlov, Budapest and Munich. Led by your local bike guide, you will cycle on e-bikes with most of the eight-day rides being relatively easy between 25kms and 50kms (3 and 5 hours) in length, with a support vehicle following the group if you get tired. With fascinating sights, stunning scenery, and a knowledgeable tour leader to guide you along the way, you'll be seeing the best of the region with the wind blowing through your hair.

YOUR ITINERARY

DAY 1 Saturday 19 September 2026

Prague

Arrive in Prague from your international flight and transfer to your hotel. At 6pm, enjoy a memorable welcome dinner at the typical Czech restaurant, U Modré Kachničky where you will try pork neck, sausages, dumplings and sauerkraut. Known as the "City of a Hundred Spires," Prague is a city rich in history, and with its stunning Gothic cathedrals, baroque façades, cobblestoned streets and trendy restaurants and bars – there's something for everyone to explore. *Overnight: Prague Leon D'oro, Prague (D)*



DAY 2 Sunday 20 September 2026

Prague

Meet your local e-bike tour leader to traverse the city's fascinating backstreets and narrow lanes on an orientation ride. Learn about the history of Prague while you ride through the Jewish Quarter, the Old Town Square – to see the Gothic Church of Our Lady before Týn, the baroque St. Nicholas Church and the Medieval Astronomical Clock on the Old Town Hall. Enjoy lunch, and see the impressive buildings at Wenceslas Square, walk across the famous Charles Bridge to the Hradčany castle district to visit Prague Castle and the Old Royal Palace, before touring the historic Malá Strana district. *Overnight: Prague Leon D'oro, Prague (B,L)*

DAY 3 Monday 21 September 2026

Karlštejn Castle – Kutná Hora – Telč

This morning, travel by coach and visit the 14th-century Gothic Karlštejn Castle which was founded



by King Charles IV of Bohemia when he was the Holy Roman Emperor. Tour the castle, which served as his private residence and a place of safekeeping royal treasure. Travel to Kutná Hora and unwind at lunch. Later, tour the macabre Sedlec Ossuary, known as the Church of Bones as it contains the skeletons of around 70,000 people which form decorations and furnishings for the chapel. Travel to the beautiful small town of Telč, check into your hotel and enjoy a typical Czech dinner. *Overnight: Hotel Antoň, Telč (B,L,D)*

DAY 4 Tuesday 22 September 2026

Třeboň – České Budějovice

Explore Telč, with its historic old square, fine castle and colourful houses before driving to the spa resort town of Třeboň to see their 16th century renaissance chateau, wander the old town and enjoy lunch. Hop on board your e-bike and travel along the Prague-Vienna Greenways main bike route, travelling 35km via lush green landscapes, past ponds and lakes to České Budějovice. The town is famous for the Budweiser Budvar Brewery – yes, this is where the name Budweiser comes from. Upon arrival, tour the Budvar brewery for a few well-earned beers at the end of a day of biking! *Overnight: Hotel Budweis, České Budějovice (B,L)*

DAY 5 Wednesday 23 September 2026

Český Krumlov

This morning, you'll tour České Budějovice's historic old town centre to see its well-preserved buildings and jump back on your e-bike for the 40km scenic ride along the Vltava River and through the rural countryside, stopping in the small town of Boršov Nad Vltavou, where you can have lunch. Arrive in medieval town of Český Krumlov,

in Bohemia's deep south in the late-afternoon. The UNESCO World Heritage Site is one of the most picturesque towns in Europe owing to its impressive castle, fascinating old town and its renaissance, gothic and baroque architecture. *Overnight: Hotel Bellevue, Český Krumlov (B)*

DAY 6 Thursday 24 September 2026

Český Krumlov

Český Krumlov, situated on the banks of the Vltava River is straight out of a storybook, with its cobblestone streets, alleyways and colourful buildings, and this morning, you'll explore the town on a guided tour. Later, enjoy some free time and perhaps find a warm and cozy restaurant at lunch, or explore the town at your own leisure. You can also visit the Egon Schiele Art Gallery or jump aboard a large canoe for a leisurely (and safe) slow trip along the river. Seeing the countryside from the water gives you stunning views of the surrounding valleys and is very popular in the town. *Overnight: Hotel Bellevue, Český Krumlov (B)*

DAY 7 Friday 25 September 2026

Lipno Lake

Rise and shine, as we're off on another day of cycling, leaving on your e-bikes just after breakfast. Ride 40kms along the river from Český Krumlov via small villages, over the plateau and down to the wooded shores of the beautiful Lipno Lake on the Czech-Austrian border. The lake is often called the "Czech Sea" due to its wide range of recreational activities in summer, and for a serene lakeside escape, this is the perfect spot! During the summer season you can ride around the lake, enjoy swimming and sailing, or just lounge comfortably on one of the Lipno beaches. *Overnight: Hotel Slunečná Louka, Lipno Lake (B,L)*



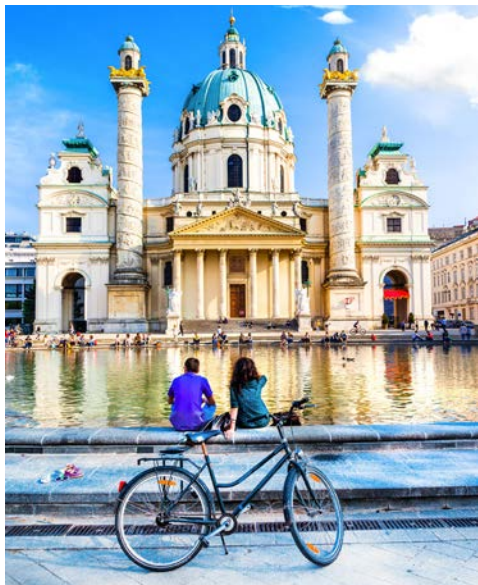
DAY 8 Saturday 26 September 2026 **Passau**

This morning, you'll drive the two hours via hilly landscapes in Austria to the German town of Passau – the meeting place of three rivers: the Danube, the Inn and the Ilz. Upon arrival, you'll tour the narrow lanes, tunnels and archways of the Altstadt old town, enjoy free time at lunch and visit Dom St Stephan to see and hear the world's largest organ – which contains an astonishing 17,974 pipes. At 3pm, board the A-ROSA River Cruise for your 8-day cruise along the Danube River. As the ship departs, enjoy the thrill of heading off along the Danube for the first time. Welcome aboard! *Overnight: A-ROSA (B,L,D)*



DAY 9 Sunday 27 September 2026 **Vienna**

This morning, you'll cruise the Danube seeing striking river landscapes and hilltop castles through the famous Wachau Danube valley between Melk and Krems. Continue on, and arrive in Vienna at 2pm. Upon arrival, pedal the imperial boulevards of the city with a 30km e-bike ride around the famous Ringstrasse Loop, where you can enjoy views of iconic landmarks such as the Vienna State Opera, the University of Vienna, and City Hall. The broad cycling path is surrounded by trees, making it a pleasant ride. Return to your ship for dinner. *Overnight: A-ROSA (B,L,D)*



DAY 10 Monday 28 September 2026 **Vienna**

This morning, you'll tour the city visiting Prater Park and the Giant Ferris Wheel, Hofburg Palace, the Austrian Parliament Building, the Burgtheater, and the Rathaus Town Hall. Along the way, you'll experience Viennese coffee culture with a stop at the stylish Landtmann café to try the famous Viennese Coffee and an Apple Strudel. After lunch on the ship, tour St. Stephen's Cathedral, Stephansplatz, Stadtpark, Karlsplatz with its magnificent Church of St. Charles. In the late afternoon, return to your ship for dinner. *Overnight: A-ROSA (B,L,D)*



DAY 11 Tuesday 29 September 2026 **Esztergom, Budapest**

At 8am, your ship will arrive at Esztergom, the former capital of Hungary where you'll visit the magnificent Castle Hill which is crowned by the largest basilica in the country. Later, glide past Visegrád Citadel, enjoy lunch and cruise past Széchenyi Chain Bridge and the House of Parliament building, arriving in Budapest at 3pm. On arrival, hop on an e-bike for a 25km journey along the Danube and via typical countryside to the charming baroque town of Szentendre. Tour the town, which is renowned for its artistic heritage and riverside setting, and return to your ship via coach for dinner. *Overnight: A-ROSA (B,L,D)*

DAY 12 Wednesday 30 September 2026 **Budapest**

This morning, you'll tour Andrásy Avenue, Heroes' Square, St. Stephen's Basilica, Freedom Square see The Shoes on the Danube Bank, plus the Széchenyi Baths and Gellért Baths. Many associate Budapest with its thermal bath culture, which is why it's also known as the City of Spas. Return to your ship for lunch, before discovering the historic Fisherman's Bastion, Matthias Church, the Buda Castle District and the Citadella landmark, which tops Gellért Hill. The ship departs at 3.30pm. *Overnight: A-ROSA (B,L,D)*

DAY 13 Thursday 1 October 2026 **Bratislava**

Arrive in Slovakia's capital of Bratislava at 9am and explore the city via e-bike with your guide. On your 20km ride, you'll see the picturesque Blue Church, Bratislava Castle and St. Martin's Cathedral. You will cycle across the iconic Most SNP Bridge (aka the UFO Bridge) over the Danube, see Devín Castle, and the communist-era housing estates of Petržalka. Later, return to the ship for lunch and stroll the medieval old town to see Michael's Gate and the quirky statues such as Man at Work, Schone Naci and Napoleon's Army Soldier. Depart on your ship at 3.30pm. *Overnight: A-ROSA (B,L,D)*

DAY 14 Friday 2 October 2026 **Krems and Melk**

At 8am, your cruise ship docks at the charming medieval town of Krems, which is known for its rich heritage and beautiful buildings reminiscent

of the Middle Ages. Tour the town, seeing old townhouses and beautiful arcaded courtyards before continuing along the Danube past the iconic Aggstein Castle and the Schönbühel Castle to Melk in the Danube Valley, arriving at 12:30pm. On arrival, wander the town visiting Melk Abbey, a magnificent Baroque structure which stands proudly on top of a rocky hill. Return to your ship, enjoy lunch and cruise towards Passau. *Overnight: A-ROSA (B,L,D)*

DAY 15 Saturday 3 October 2026 **Passau, Munich**

Depart the ship after breakfast at 8am and drive to Munich. Upon arrival, enjoy free time at lunch at the culinary paradise of the Viktualienmarkt open-air farmers' market. Later, visit the Old Town Hall, Frauenkirche Cathedral and Marienplatz and the neo-Gothic Neues Rathaus to see its gargoyles and Glockenspiel clock. Visit the grounds of the famous Oktoberfest, the world's largest folk festival which celebrates Bavarian culture with beer, food, and festivities. Visit one of the lively beer halls for an authentic experience and to see the traditional Dirndl and Lederhosen outfits. *Overnight: Hotel Kriemhild Am Hirschgarten, Munich (B,D)*



DAY 16 Sunday 4 October 2026 **Munich**

This morning, you'll head off on your e-bikes for a ride through the Baroque Nymphenburg Palace Gardens and the leafy English Garden, one of the largest urban parks in the world. Ride through Forstenrieder Park, meandering through Bavarian villages and arrive at Lake Starnberg. Enjoy a hearty Schweinhaxen pork knuckle at lunch, enjoy some free time at the lake, with its crystal-clear waters and wonderful views of the surrounding mountains and drive back to Munich. Enjoy a farewell dinner together at the historic premises of the Hofbräuhaus beer hall and restaurant. *Overnight: Hotel Kriemhild Am Hirschgarten, Munich (B,L,D)*

DAY 17 Monday 5 October 2026 **Munich / Depart**

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and make your way to the airport for your flight home. (B)



A-ROSA BELLA

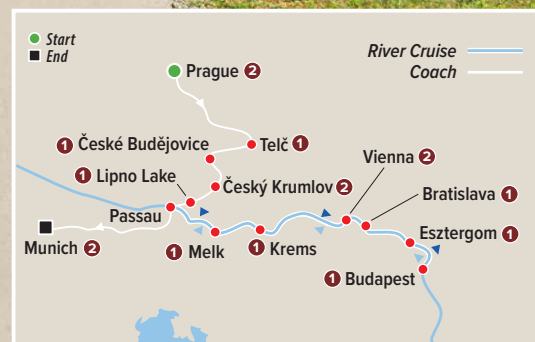
