Feeling suitably exhilarated we travel a short journey through the Cape Winelands to Pearl Valley. The course has panoramic views of spectacular mountain ranges and extensive vineyards. The fairways are unique in South Africa having been sown with 'all-seasons cool grass' imported from the USA.



## DAY 3 Saturday 10 October 2026

#### Hermanus

### Arabella – Play Arabella

(Golf Digest Top 100 Courses South Africa #8)
Today we take a short drive to play the # 9
ranked course in South Africa, Arabella. This
championship course is situated alongside
a lagoon bordering the Kogelberg Nature
Reserve, with spectacular views of the Kogelberg
mountain range. Our previous groups declared
Arabella to be one of their favourites.
Hotel: Arabella Hotel and Golf Spa.

#### DAY 4 Sunday 11 October 2026

#### Hermanus & George

After breakfast we will take a short drive to the scenic town of Hermanus recognised by the WWF as one of the 12 best whale watching destinations in the world. With any luck, we will get a close-up view of the migrating Southern Right Whale. After hopefully getting some great photos of the whales we continue our adventure along the world-famous Garden Route towards George. Hotel: Fancourt Resort.

#### DAY 5 Monday 12 October 2026

#### Knysna & George

#### Play Pezula Golf Club

(Golf Digest Top 100 Courses South Africa 2016/17 # 20)

Today we travel to Knysna and play Pezula Championship Course. It is undoubtedly one of the world's most beautiful 18 holes. With sweeping ocean and lagoon views, a round at Pezula is both a sporting and visual experience. As a Top 20 South African ranked course, Pezula's championship design offers a challenge for the seasoned golfer while still being the perfect day out for any skill level. Also be careful of the baboons – they might eat your lunch. After golf we drive to Knysna Elephant Park where we will get up close and personal



with African elephants, on elephant terms. Responsible and educational interactions will allow us to appreciate the awe-inspiring presence of these animals, but still give the elephants the space and freedom to choose where they want to move, what they want to eat and who they want to interact with.

#### DAY 6 Tuesday 13 October 2026 George

#### Play Fancourt Montagu

(Golf Digest Top 100 Courses South Africa #12)
Today we will play the exquisitely conditioned
Montagu at the heart of Fancourt, with its
glorious parkland layout, covering large tracts
of varying terrain on rolling land. Its beauty is
enhanced by mature trees, flower beds, shrubs
and water hazards that provide a colourful
contrast to the landscape.



DAY 7 Wednesday 14 October 2026 George

#### Play the Fancourt Links

(Golf Digest Top 100 Courses South Africa # 2)
To play world-renowned Fancourt Links you must stay at Fancourt Country Club Estate. The course has received accolades from Jack Nicklaus, Ernie Els and, of course, Gary Player! It hosted the 2003 Presidents Cup, always remembered for its darkness-enforced draw, when Tiger and Ernie couldn't be separated. The course was elevated to #1 in the latest Golf Digest rankings after the completion of major work by Gary Player Design on greens and bunkers and with considerable emphasis on making the course more playable (but never easy!) for all levels of golfers.

#### DAY 8 Thursday 15 October 2026 Kruger

Today we fly to the awe-inspiring Kruger National Park, where the magnificent 'Big 5' roam free. It is divided into six different eco-systems and is estimated to have nearly 2,000 different types of plant species. You will have the thrill and spectacle of encountering a vast array of animals in their natural habitat. *Hotel: Buhala Lodge*.

## DAY 9 Friday 16 October 2026

#### Kruger

#### Play Mbompela Golf Course

Today we enjoy a round of golf at the scenic Mbombela Golf Club, located in the heart of Mpumalanga. Surrounded by lush landscapes and distant mountain views, this well-established course offers a relaxed yet rewarding golfing experience. With its tree-lined fairways, manicured greens, and warm hospitality, Mbombela Golf Club is a favourite among local and visiting golfers alike.

#### DAY 10 Saturday 17 October 2026 Kruger

Early this morning we will head out for our Safari in Kruger National Park. Hopefully we will see the 'Big 5' (Lion, Leopard, Elephant, Rhino and Buffalo) We may well also see giraffes, cheetahs and hippos; as for zebras, springboks and impala, they are so profuse you have to ask the ranger to stop to take a photograph! Much of what you see is from quite close too. Unforgettable!

#### DAY 11 Sunday 18 October 2026 Kruger

#### Play Leopard Creek

(Golf Digest Top 100 Courses South Africa #5)
This morning we play at Leopard Creek. The exclusive Leopard Creek Country Club is just a lion's roar from Kruger Game Reserve, close to the southern border of the park, on the banks of the Crocodile River. This stunning bushveldt course is meticulously laid out to provide a challenge to the professional but also enjoyment to the average player. Big game is part of the charm of the course, including lions, crocodiles and hippos. Let them play through! It is fair to say that you haven't really played golf in South Africa unless you have played Leopard Creek.



DAY 12 Monday 19 October, 2026 Sun City

Today is a travel day as we journey from the wilds of Kruger National Park to the luxury of Sun City. We begin with a flight to Johannesburg, where we'll meet our coach for the scenic transfer to Sun City. Nestled in the foothills of the Pilanesberg Mountains, this iconic resort offers a unique blend of relaxation, entertainment, and home to two championship golf courses. Hotel: The Palace at Lost City Hotel, Sun City Resort.





DAY 13 Tuesday 20 October 2026 Sun City

#### Play Lost City

Today we will play Lost City. Covering more than 100 hectares and 28,000 square metres of water features the course has spectacular views across the bushveld, huge waste bunkers, lots of water hazards, pristine fairways and receptive greens. The 13th hole, where the green is shaped to resemble the continent of Africa, is protected by 9 bunkers and crocodiles.

#### DAY 14 Wednesday 21 October 2026 Sun City

Today we will have a game drive in the 57,000 hectares of the Pilanesberg Game Reserve brimming with almost all of Southern Africa's game species. On the transition zone of the Kalahari and the Lowveld Pilanesberg offers a unique mix of fauna and flora. A game drive in Pilanesberg in an open safari vehicle allows close encounters with lion, leopard, elephant, rhino and buffalo. The Big 5 are joined by abundance of game including rare species such as wild dog or cheetah. More than 300 bird species make things interesting for avid birders.



DAY 15 Thursday 22 October 2026 Sun City

#### Play Gary Player Country Club

(Golf Digest Top 100 Courses South Africa #11)
Today we will play the Gary Player Country Club, which is consistently ranked at the very top in the country and is home to the annual Nedbank Challenge. The strength of this golf course lies in the fact that it doesn't favour any particular shot, and provides the same result whether playing the forward or intermediate tees. 8000 yards of golfing pleasure await each player with mesmerising views at every turn. This evening, we will enjoy a farewell dinner and presentation of prizes.

## DAY 16 Friday 23 October 2026

#### Departure

This morning we will depart for our journey to Johannesburg airport. The tour concludes when we arrive at the airport for your flights back to Australia.
