

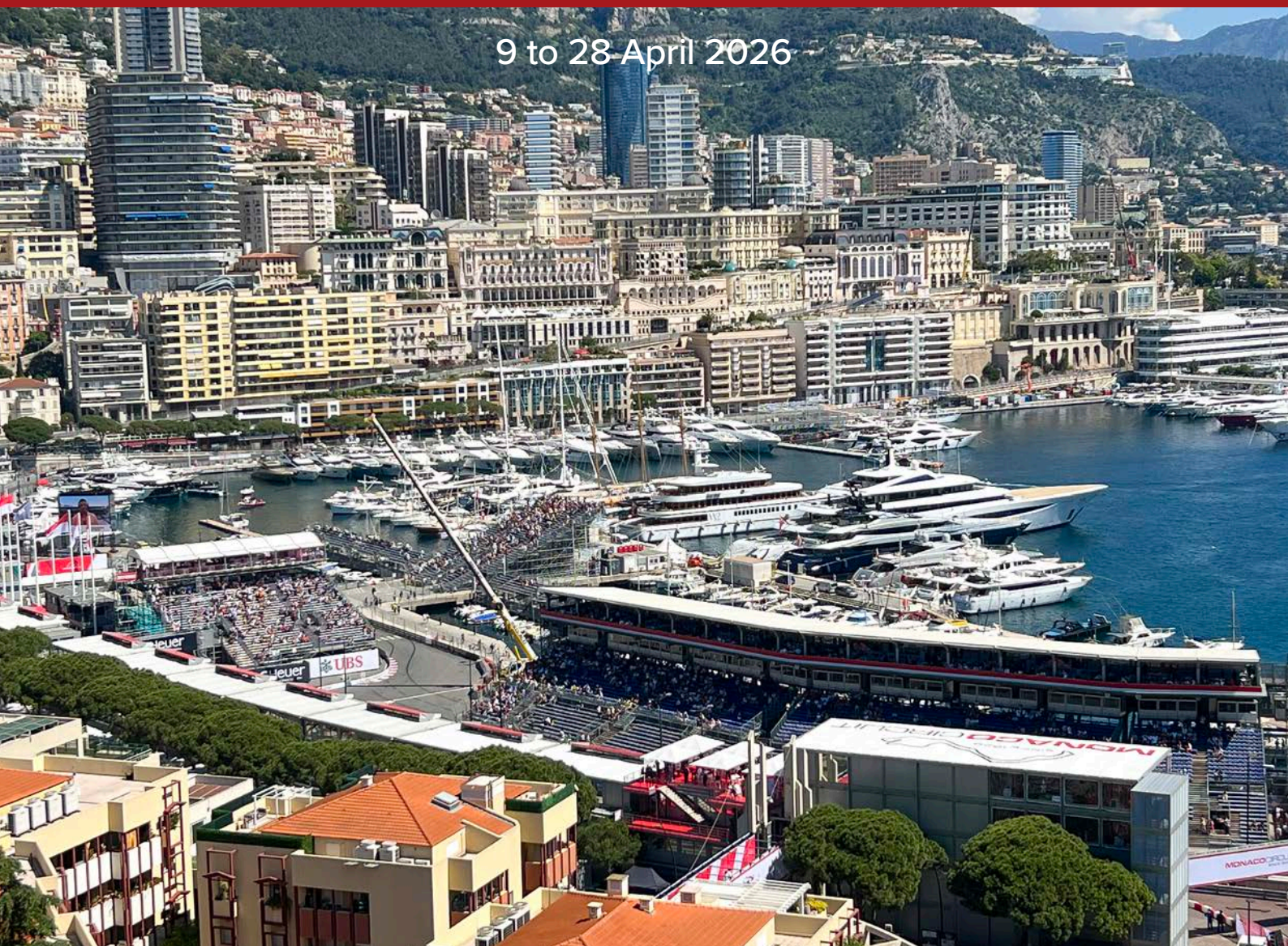

## YOUR ITINERARY

### DAY 1 Thursday April 9, 2026

#### Departure

We depart Australia today on our flight to Dusseldorf.

### DAY 2 Friday April 10, 2026

#### Essen

On arrival into Dusseldorf early evening we are met by our coach and transferred to the city of Essen where we stay for the next three nights.

### Day 3 Saturday April 11, 2026

#### Essen

Today we visit Technica Classica Essen which is one of the largest classic car shows in the world. With an exhibition area of over 120,000 m<sup>2</sup> divided into 8 halls and 2 open air areas it is a feast for car lovers. It is more than 1250 exhibitors from over 30 countries and more than 200 clubs and groups exhibiting and over 3000 vehicles on display. It will be one of the highlights of the tour!

### Day 4 Sunday April 12, 2026

#### Essen

Our second day to explore the Technica Classica Essen.

### DAY 5 Monday April 13, 2026

#### Nurburgring

Today we will travel to Nurburg for one of the highlights of the tour, where we will have the chance to drive the famous Nurburgring. The Nurburgring, nicknamed "The Green Hell" by Jackie Stewart, is widely considered one of the most demanding and difficult purpose-built racing circuits in the world. The home of the German Grand Prix until 1939 on the full circuit and until 1977 on the northern circuit, driving this amazing track will be a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity. We will visit the Nurburg museum that details the history of this extraordinary race track. We will also have an included dinner to celebrate our time at the Nurburgring at the Schmidt family restaurant.



### DAY 6 Tuesday April 14, 2026

#### Nurburgring

Today we take a driving tour around the area on public roads in a collection of sports cars where we learn about the history of this iconic track. We will change cars frequently so that everyone has the chance to drive each of the various high performance vehicles including Porsches.

### DAY 7 Wednesday April 15, 2026

#### Stuttgart

This morning we travel south to Speyer and then to the Auto and Technik Museum at Sinsheim which contains over 300 classic cars as well as motorcycles, aircraft and military equipment and see their impressive collection. We then continue on to Stuttgart and our hotel.

### DAY 8 Thursday April 16, 2026

#### Stuttgart

This morning, we visit the Mercedes Museum. The museum details the development of the automobile, from its invention to the present day. One of the most impressive auto museums in the world it contains over 160 vehicles on display. In the afternoon we visit the Porsche Museum, which is located in a spectacular modern architectural building. We then visit the Porsche factory to see how these iconic sport cars are made.







**DAY 9 Friday April 17, 2026**  
**Modena**

We depart Stuttgart this morning and fly to Italy. On arrival we visit the design house Bertone collection of cars. We then continue on to Modena the centre of the exotic Italian motor industry and our hotel.



**DAY 10 Saturday April 18, 2026**  
**Modena**

We visit the home of Lamborghini in the town of Sant'Agata Bolognese, south of Bologna. We have a tour of the factory where these amazing supercars are manufactured. We will see the assembly line of the Gallardo LP 560-4 and follow step by-step, the making of a car: from the body shell to the interior and the mounting of Lamborghini's V10 engine. We will then visit the acclaimed Lamborghini Museum, which has an example of almost every vehicle manufactured by the company. We then travel to the town of San Cesario sul Panaro, where the relatively new Maserati of Pagani is manufactured. We visit the factory and find out how these amazing vehicles are manufactured.

**DAY 11 Sunday April 19, 2026**  
**Modena**

This morning we visit the Righini Collection of classic cars. The collection has a particular emphasis on classic Alfa Romeos. We then visit the Stanguellini Museum that details the history of the oldest automotive manufacturer in Modena. We continue to the Museo Ferruccio Lamborghini which details the life of the founder of Lamborghini and his development of the famous sports cars. This afternoon we have a tour of the Maserati factory in Moden to see how these exotic vehicles are made. We then return to the hotel.

**DAY 12 Monday April 20, 2026**  
**Modena**

This morning we will visit the Enzo Ferrari Museum. Built around the home Enzo Ferrari grew up in, the museum details the great car

manufacturer's life amongst a classic collection of some of the cars he created. We then travel to Maranello, where the Ferrari factory is located, visit the Ferrari museum and take a bus tour through the factory grounds. The ground floor of the museum is dedicated to Formula One; upstairs are the Ferrari road cars, where pride of place goes to The Enzo, the car dedicated to its founder. We have an included lunch today, at the Ristorante Cavallino, the famous restaurant across the road from the factory, where Enzo Ferrari used to dine. L

**DAY 13 Tuesday April 21, 2026**  
**Modena**

This morning we visit the Panini collection of Maserati cars. Founded by Umberto Panini, the collection is the finest in the world. We then visit the Dallara Academy Museum which details the Dallara company's association with motorsport over the years. We then return to the hotel.

**DAY 14 Wednesday April 22, 2026**  
**Turin**

Today we depart Modena and travel first to the Alfa Romeo museum in Milan. This extensive museum is devoted to the famed Alfa Romeo brand detailing its history. We then continue to the city of Turin and our hotel.

**DAY 15 Thursday April 23, 2026**  
**Turin**

Today we will visit the very impressive National Automobile Museum of Italy. The collection has around 200 cars and includes the first Italian cars, Bernardi 1896 and 1899 Fiat, the Rolls Royce Silver Ghost 1914, and racing cars by Ferrari and Alfa Romeo. We then visit the old Fiat factory and see the renowned test track on the roof that appeared in the film "The Italian Job" starring Michael Caine. In the afternoon



we visit the The FCA Heritage Hub which is devoted to the history of the Fiat, Lancia and Abarth marques. An impressive collection! Those wishing to dine together can meet in the lobby, where the tour manager will suggest good-value restaurants for dinner.

**Day 16 Friday April 24, 2026**  
**Monaco**

This morning we visit the design house Pininfarina where we see their unique collection of vehicles in their museum. We continue on to the Principality of Monaco and our hotel. Enjoy staying in Monaco during our time at the Monaco Historic Grand Prix!

**DAY 17 Saturday April 25, 2026**  
**Monaco Historic Grand Prix**

Today we enjoy one of the highlights of the tour. We will be guided to our grandstand seats at the biennial Monaco Historic Grand Prix. This is not just another race track, this is Monaco, the crown jewel of motor racing since the earliest days of the sport. See historic racing and sports cars navigate the twisting Monaco track in one of the most glamorous places in the world. See the Bugattis, Alfas, Maseratis, Ferraris and other classics, some of which are worth millions, reliving the days of some of the most famous drivers, in this, the most stylish of racing tracks. **DAY 18 Sunday April 26, 2026**  
**Monaco Historic Grand Prix**

Take your grandstand seats for the finals of the 2026 Monaco Historic Grand Prix. A fantastic day to enjoy the unique atmosphere of this event in the heart of Monaco. Then after the event, enjoy the many attractions this principality has to offer.

**DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT:** A non-refundable deposit of \$1200 per passenger should be sent with a completed Travelrite International booking. As soon as the booking is confirmed, (usually within 24 hours), a confirmation advice will be posted to the client. Final payments are due to be paid to Travelrite International 60 days prior to the commencement of the tour. A 1.5% administration fee will be added to payments by credit card. Tour prices have been determined with exchange rates as of 1 March 2025.
