DAY 1 Friday, 26 June 2026 Depart Australia

Today we depart Australia on our overnight flights to Rome.

DAY 2 Saturday, 27 June 2026 Rome, Italy

This afternoon we arrive in Rome. We will be met by our private coach and are transferred into the city of Rome where we check into our hotel.

DAY 3 Sunday, 28 June 2026 Rome

Today we enjoy a sightseeing tour of the 'Eternal City' and see the Colosseum, the Pantheon, the Spanish Steps and the Trevi Fountain, where group members can throw a coin and make a wish to return to Rome one day. After lunch we will visit the Vatican City. We visit St Peter's Basilica where we have a chance to see Michelangelo's Pieta statue and the fantastic interiors of the Basilica.



DAY 4 Monday, 29 June 2026 Embarkation

The morning is free to explore Rome. We are then transferred to the port of Civitavecchia, Rome to embark the Celebrity Constellation.

DAY 5 Tuesday, 30 June 2026 Tuscany (Livorno), Italy

This morning we arrive in the port city of Livorno. We travel through the Tuscan countryside to the town of San Gimignano, known as the "City of Beautiful Towers", a classic medieval walled hill-town in Tuscany, famous for its architecture and its 14 surviving towers creating a beautiful skyline visible from the surrounding countryside. The Celebrity Constellation remains docked overnight in Livorno.

DAY 6 Wednesday, 1 July 2026 Tuscany

This morning we travel to Pisa, the city of the Leaning Tower. Located in the Piazza dei Miracoli (Plaza of Miracles), this near 56-metre structure will astound you, viewed from all angles. We will continue our journey to Lucca, a walled Tuscan treasure. We will stroll along its Renaissance ramparts, see the tree-topped Guinigi Tower, admire San Michele in Foro, and enjoy some free time in Piazza dell'Anfiteatro.



DAY 7 Thursday, 2 July 2026 At Sea

A day at sea to enjoy the facilities of the ship. This afternoon join Julie for a discussion about her life in the media.

DAY 8 Friday, 3 July 2026 Sorrento, Italy

We arrive into Salerno this morning. We have a morning tour of the beautiful resort town of Sorrento with its spectacular views of the Bay of Naples. We then visit the ancient, perfectly preserved ruins of Pompeii, a wealthy settlement of the Roman Empire, destroyed by the eruption of Vesuvius in 79AD. We will have a tour of the ruins with a local guide to see the Forum, the House of the Vetti, a well preserved aristocratic villa and much more.

DAY 9 Saturday, 4 July 2026 Taormina, Italy

Today we call in to the island of Sicily. We travel from Messina down to the famous resort of Taormina, spectacularly located high on a 200-metre-high rocky outcrop, with views to

Mt Etna. The town, founded by the Greeks, has an ancient theatre that also overlooks the mountain. Since the 18th century, Taormina has been a popular travel destination. We will walk around the medieval centre and visit Piazza IX Aprile, with its views overlooking Mt Etna and the sea. We will visit Torre dell'Orologio, a restored 12th-century clock tower and the famous Ancient Greek theatre, founded in the third century BC and rebuilt by the Romans at the end of the first century – it is spectacularly sited with views of Mt Etna in the distance.

DAY 10 Sunday, 5 July 2026 At Sea

A day at sea to enjoy the facilities of the ship. This afternoon join Julie for a fun game of trivia.

DAY 11 Monday, 6 July 2026 Kotor, Montenegro

Today we sail up the picturesque Bay of Kotor, a submerged river canyon. A fantastic landscape is created by the overhanging limestone cliffs of Orjen and Lovcen. The town was founded by the ancient Romans in 168 BC and conquered by the Venetians in the 15th century. The port of Kotor was built by the Republic of Venice and is surrounded by impressive city walls. There are many attractive Venetian buildings in the town. We will have a morning tour to explore this interesting city.

DAY 12 Tuesday, 7 July 2026 Dubrovnik, Croatia

This morning we call into the historic city of Dubrovnik. Known as The Jewel of the Adriatic, the city is situated on a promontory surrounded by the beautiful waters of the Adriatic Sea. It is renowned for the beauty of its monuments, its magnificent city walls and welcoming atmosphere. It was founded by fugitives from the Roman city of Epidaurum during the seventh century. We have a comprehensive tour of Dubrovnik and see the impressive Fort of St John and the Sponza Palace, which was built in the 14th century as the Mint for the city.



DAY 13 Wednesday, 8 July 2026 Split, Croatia

Today we visit Split, the second largest city in Croatia. The old town grew up around the Emperor Diocletian's vast Roman Palace. We have a morning sightseeing tour, during which we visit the interior courtyard of the Roman complex and the Golden Gate, the main entrance to Diocletian's Palace. We visit the Baptistry of St John, a small, beautiful building consecrated in the sixth century and see the Renaissance Town Hall on People's Square surrounded by Venetian buildings.

DAY 14 Thursday, 9 July 2026 Zadar, Croatia

Today, Julie will accompany us on an excursion to the stunning Krka National Park. The national park is a vast and primarily unaltered area of exceptional natural value, including one or more preserved or insignificantly altered ecosystems. The top attraction of the Park is its magnificent waterfalls, including the famous Skradinski Buk falls, which are one of Croatia's most famous sights. Other highlights include the small island of Visovac and Roski Slap waterfall. After lunch, we enjoy a boat trip through the park to Skradin.

DAY 15 Friday, 10 July 2026 Venice, Italy

Today arrive into Ravenna. We disembark the ship and visit the historic city of Ravenna, located on the Adriatic coast in north-east Italy. It was briefly the capital of the Roman Empire and later, the Italian capital of the Byzantine Empire. During this time, incredible mosaics were constructed throughout the city. Described as a symphony of colour in Dante's Divine Comedy, Ravenna's well-preserved mosaics are some of the finest remaining in the Western world. We then continue to Venice and check into our hotel.

DAY 16 Saturday, 11 July 2026 Venice

Today we will have a sightseeing tour of this beautiful city. We visit St Mark's Square, see the Grand Canal, St Mark's Cathedral, the Doge's Palace and the Bridge of Sighs. We will wind our way through the narrow alleyways to the Rialto



market square. There will be free time in the afternoon to explore the meandering laneways and bridges of this magical city. Perhaps try an espresso or gelato and take in the sights and sounds of Venice.

DAY 17 Sunday, 12 July 2026 Venice

A free day to explore Venice. You may wish to take an optional day tour to the nearby islands of Murano and Burano.

DAY 18 Monday, 13 July 2026 Departure

At midday the group will be transferred to Venice airport for the flight back to Australia.

DAY 19 Tuesday, 14 July 2026 Arrive Australia

Tour members arrive back in Australia. The tour concludes
