#### DAY 1 Tuesday 24 February 2026

#### **Arrive Christchurch**

Group members fly to Christchurch, New Zealand, and upon arrival we transfer to our city hotel. This evening we have a welcome dinner so you can meet other passengers in the group.

#### DAY 2 Wednesday 25 February 2026

#### Christchurg

On our excursion today we travel on one of the most scenic train journeys in New Zealand – the TranzAlpine Express Train. From Christchurch, we cross the flat Canterbury Plains to the small community of Darfield. We continue through beautiful alpine scenery as we enter the Arthur's Pass National Park. Marvel at the alpine scenery as we sit back and enjoy the commentary.



#### DAY 3 Thursday 26 February 2026

#### Wellington

This morning we board The Coastal Pacific train to Picton. Travelling via Kaikoura, the home of whale watching and then onto the gateway to the beautiful Marlborough Sound with the famous wine growing region of Blenheim. The journey takes us through some of New Zealand's finest horticultural and farmland areas of the Canterbury Plains to the rugged Kaikoura mountain ranges on one side of our train, the Pacific Ocean coastline on the other with views of marine wildlife such as seals and penguins all from the comfort of our carriage. Arriving into Picton we transfer to the ferry port for a short journey across Cook Strait to Wellington.

#### DAY 4 Friday 27 February 2026

#### Auckland

This morning we board the Northern Explorer train for our journey to Auckland. The train service is a scenic rail journey through the five unique geographical regions of the North Island. We travel from Wellington, through the central heartland of the Northern Island. Along the way, we enjoy the farming landscapes and rocky sea scapes of the lower North Island and ascend through stunning river gorges to the volcanic plateau passing the majestic volcanoes of Mt Tongariro, Mt Ngauruhoe and Mt Ruapehu, the home of the North Island ski fields. Upon arrival in Auckland, New Zealand's largest city, we are transferred to our hotel.



#### DAY 5 Saturday 28 February 2026

#### Aucklan

Today we travel to Waiuku to experience the golden era of "steam age" train travel at the Glenbrook Vintage Railway operating through picturesque rural countryside over 7.4 km of the former New Zealand Railways (NZR). The Glenbrook Vintage Railway owns and operates a number of historic and valuable heritage locomotives both steam and diesel, from the smallest locomotive, a 3 ton diesel shunter, to the giant 110 ton JA 1250 "Diana" steam locomotive. We then enjoy a sightseeing tour of gorgeous Auckland, the largest city and commercial centre of New Zealand. Our tour takes in the main sights of the city, including the Harbour Bridge, which spans the beautiful Waitemata Harbour.

#### DAY 6 Sunday 1 March 2026

#### Embarkation

The morning is free. At midday we board the MS Noordam for our cruise around New Zealand. Be up on deck as we cruise out of Auckland harbour.

#### DAY 7 Monday 2 March 2026

#### Tauranga

This morning we arrive in Tauranga, a harbourside city in the Bay of Plenty region on New Zealand's North Island. Today we will enjoy a magical rail experience. We first travel inland to Mamaku, past Lake Rotorua, and board our own self-drive Rail Cruiser to travel through

the beautiful Dansey Road Scenic Reserve, on the steep 1:35 gradient railway between Mamaku and Tarukenga. We then see the famous geysers and volcanic activity of Rotorua

#### DAY 8 Tuesday 3 March 2026

#### Napie

Today we board the Hawke's Bay Express, a modern road trolley train. As the bell rings and the whistle blows, you're transported back in time for an Art Deco Napier experience. As you travel through town and towards Ahuriri, you'll hear about the catastrophic 1931 earthquake and the city's subsequent Art Deco-style rebuild, plus fascinating Māori legends that highlight the Bay's history.

#### DAY 9 Wednesday 4 March 2026

#### Wellington

This morning we will have a sightseeing tour of the main sights of Wellington, including the Houses of Parliament known as "the Beehive". We visit Mount Victoria, where we have 360 degree views of the city, then travel by cable car to the Botanical Gardens. This afternoon will be free to explore Wellington or perhaps visit the award winning Te Papa Museum.

#### DAY 10 Thursday 5 March 2026

#### **Picton**

This morning we arrive in Picton, located in one of the sunniest parts of New Zealand, the top of the South Island, it is a quaint port town nestled deep in the Marlborough Sounds. Our train journey today is on board the Marlborough Flyer, a WWI Memorial heritage steam train built in 1915. The hour-long Steam Train journey takes you up the challenging and steep elevation out of Picton (1-in-37 slope), through the Para Wetlands, across the Wairau River into the Wairau Valley and through a sea of vineyards into Blenheim.



#### DAY 11 Friday 6 March 2026

#### Christchurch

We begin the day with a sightseeing tour of Christchurch with its very English feel. It is the largest city on the South Island of New Zealand. The city boasts modern architecture and historic buildings set against beautiful parks, gardens, rivers and beaches. We then drive to the nearby village of Akaroa. Originally founded by the French, it is now a delightful town, retaining the ambience of France.

#### DAY 12 Saturday 7 March 2026

#### Dunedir

Our Dunedin train journey today is the Taieri Gorge Railway. Departing from Dunedin's beautiful railway station, our train begins its scenic journey into some of New Zealand's ever-changing, most spectacular and iconic scenery on its journey to Pukerangi, a peaceful outcrop out the other side of the Taieri Gorge. The train travels through the Southern parts of Dunedin city until it arrives at Wingatui junction, where it turns off onto the Taieri branch. From here the train sneaks across the Taieri

Plains and climbs into the Taieri Gorge, a narrow and deep gorge carved out over aeons by the ancient Taieri River. The train will stop or slow down at various scenic points along the way for photos where we can disembark and stretch our legs and enjoy the best of beauty, peace and quiet that nature has to offer.



#### DAY 13 Sunday 8 March 2026

#### Fiordland National Park

Today we cruise through some of the most spectacular scenery in New Zealand as we visit Milford Sound followed by Doubtful and Dusky Sounds. The fiords will be a highlight of the cruise, with spectacular scenery and fascinating wildlife. Nothing can prepare you for the majesty of Milford Sound, star of Fiordland National Park. New vistas mesmerise at each turn – towering Mitre Peak, rising 1692 metres above the Sound, plunging waterfalls, bottlenose and dusky dolphins, fur seals and Fiordland crested penguins are amongst this wonderland of outstanding natural beauty

#### DAY 18 Friday 13 March 2026

Melbourne

This morning we arrive in the port of Melbourne, where we travel by coach to the Dandenong Ranges to take a journey on Puffing Billy. This century old steam train travels from Belgrave Station through to Gembrook, with a post-preservation history spanning over 50 years, the line is one of the most popular steam heritage railways in the world. The line was originally opened in 1900 to serve the local farming and timber community and originally ran from Upper Ferntree Gully station. In 1955 the Puffing Billy Preservation Society was formed to keep the train running indefinitely.
