PRE CRUISE TOUR TO VICTORIA FALLS AND CHOBE NATIONAL PARK

DAY 1 Saturday 24 January 2026 Depart

We depart Australia on our overnight flights to South Africa.

DAY 2 Sunday 25 January 2026 Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

This morning we arrive into Johannesburg and take a connecting flight to Victoria Falls where we meet our tour manager for the extension. Victoria Falls are among the most spectacular waterfalls in the world. The Zambezi River, which is more than 2 kilometres wide at this point, plunges noisily down a series of basalt gorges and raises an iridescent mist that can be seen more than 20 kilometres away.

DAY 3 Monday 26 January 2026 Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

This morning we enjoy a tour of the great falls and experience one of the major natural wonders of the world. The afternoon is free – you may like to take a short helicopter ride to view the falls from above or enjoy a sunset dinner cruise on the Zambezi.

DAY 4 Tuesday 27 January 2026 Chobe National Park, Botswana

Today we travel across the border to Botswana, to our wonderful Lodge in the Chobe National Park. The park extends over 117 00 sq kms, encompassing floodplains, swamps, woodland and the Chobe River. The park boats over 450 species of birds plus Giraffe, Lions, Cape Buffalo, Hippos, Crocodile, Leopard, Impala, Elephants and Zebra, all of which are frequently viewed on Safari.



DAY 5 Wednesday 28 January 2026 Chobe National Park

Our second day on safari in the Chobe National Park is sure to be another day of great wildlife sightseeing and memorable experiences. We will enjoy a 4 x 4 safari and hopefully see the 'Big 5' – Lion, Leopard, Elephant, Rhino and Buffalo.

DAY 6 Thursday 29 January 2026 Cape Town

Today we will fly to Cape Town and meet up with the remainder of our group!

We depart Australia on our overnight flights to South Africa.

Today we arrive into Cape Town – one of the great cities of the world. 
