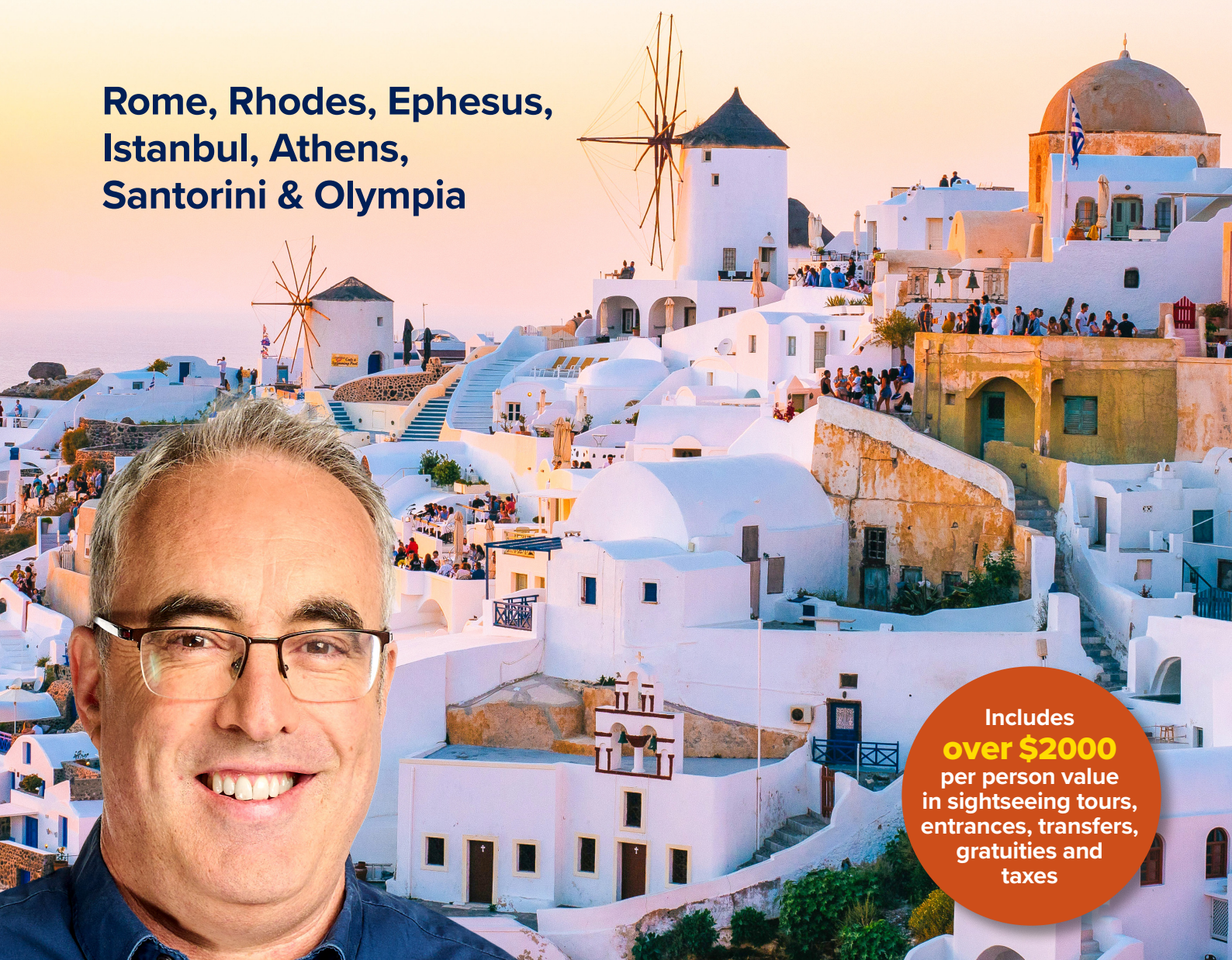

Itinerary

DAY 1 Friday, 18 September 2026 **Depart Australia**

Today we board our flights to Rome.

DAY 2 Saturday, 19 September 2026 **Rome, Italy**

This afternoon we arrive into Rome. After clearing customs, we will be transferred to our hotel. We will enjoy a sightseeing tour of the 'Eternal City' and see the Colosseum, the Pantheon, the Spanish Steps and the Trevi Fountain, where group members can throw a coin and make a wish to return to Rome one day.



DAY 3 Sunday, 20 September 2026 **Rome**

Today we enjoy a day tour to Tivoli on the outskirts of Rome to visit Villa d'Este and Hadrian's Villa. Tivoli is home to luxurious residences, magnificent villas, and two famous UNESCO World Heritage sites: the Renaissance palace of Villa d'Este, known for its extravagant gardens and water fountains, and the ruins of Hadrian's Villa the grand second-century estate of Emperor Hadrian of ancient Rome. We return to Rome late afternoon. This evening we have an included welcome dinner to meet Tony and the group members.



DAY 4 Monday, 21 September 2026 **Embark Queen Victoria**

A free morning for shopping in Rome before transferring to Civitavecchia to board Queen Victoria. Make sure that you are up on deck as the Queen Victoria sets sail and we commence our Mediterranean Exploration cruise.

DAY 5 Tuesday, 22 September 2026 **At Sea**

A day at sea to enjoy the facilities of the ship. This afternoon join Tony for a discussion about his life in the media.

DAY 6 Wednesday, 23 September 2026 **At Sea**

A day at sea to enjoy the facilities of the ship. Today we have a fun game of Trivia, hosted by Tony.

DAY 7 Thursday, 24 September 2026 **Rhodes, Greece**

The ship docks at the island of Rhodes today. We will have a walking tour of the old city, once the fortified headquarters of the Crusaders and visit the Grand Masters residence. The rest of the day will be free to explore the town and its interesting shops.

DAY 8 Friday, 25 September 2026 **Ephesus, Turkey**

This morning we arrive in Kusadasi, on Turkey's Aegean coast. We travel to the ancient Roman city of Ephesus, one of the most extensive archaeological sites in the world. We walk along the marble streets, complete with chariot wheel ruts made nearly two thousand years ago. We see the imposing two storey façade of the Library of Celsus, the best-preserved structure of its kind in the world.



DAY 9 Saturday, 26 September 2026 **At Sea**

A day at sea to enjoy the facilities of the ship. This afternoon join Tony for a fun game of bingo with prizes for the winners.

DAY 10 Sunday, 27 September 2026 **Istanbul**

Today we arrive into Istanbul and enjoy a sightseeing tour of the city, the capital of the Roman, Byzantine and Ottoman Empires for nearly 1,000 years. Covering the hills on both sides of the Bosphorus, it was the halfway point between the cultures of Europe and the Orient.

Queen Victoria

Smart casual attire is required in the public lounges and restaurants.

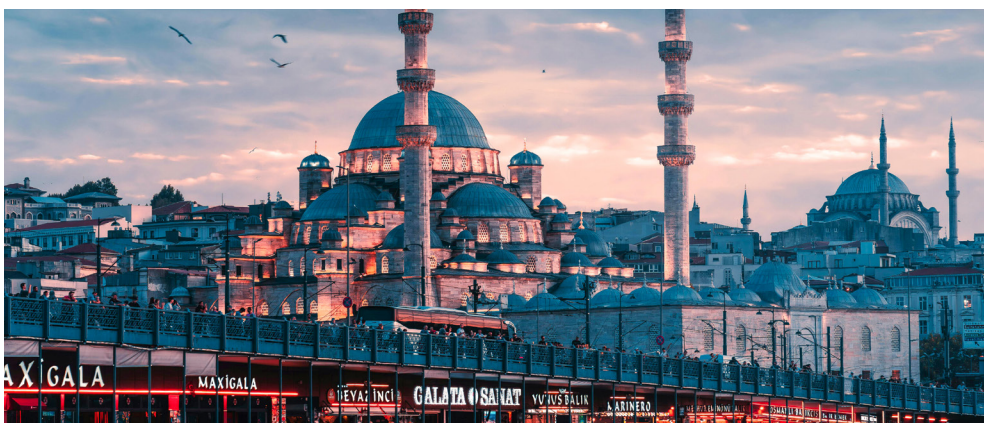

We will visit the Aya Sofya, a masterpiece of Byzantine architecture. At one time it was a cathedral, a mosque and now a magnificent museum. As we enter, we see the 9th-century bronze covered doors, you can feel the vibrant atmosphere of the city alive with movement and bustle. We then discover Istanbul's captivating Cisterns, hidden beneath the city, featuring breathtaking columns, serene waters, and centuries of history. Our last stop of the day will be a visit to the Grand Bazaar.

DAY 11 Monday, 28 September 2026 Istanbul

We continue our exploration of Istanbul this morning with a visit to Topkapi Palace. The original palace was built by Mehmet the Conqueror between 1459 and 1465 and was the home of the Ottoman Emperors until 1853. It had its own mosques, schools, libraries, Turkish baths and residences for many people working in these facilities.



DAY 12 Tuesday, 29 September 2026 At Sea

A day at sea to enjoy the facilities of the ship. This afternoon join Tony for a talk about some of his comedy exploits including developing the character of Guido Hatzis.

DAY 13 Wednesday, 30 September 2026 Athens, Greece

Today we call into the ancient city of Athens, capital of Greece. Athens is the home of the Acropolis and the ultimate in ancient Greek architectural perfection, the Parthenon, built to honour the goddess Athena. Our sightseeing tour today delves into the glorious history of Athens. We see such famous sights as the first modern Olympic stadium, the Acropolis, and Parthenon. We will have time in the Plaka district, a maze of winding streets with shops, café's and restaurants.



DAY 14 Thursday, 1 October 2026 Santorini

Today we have a day to explore Santorini, known as the "Black Pearl of the Aegean", one of the most spectacular landscapes in Greece and in

the world. The traditional villages of the island, built on tall cliffs, offer a breath-taking view over the submerged volcano. They represent the most beautiful island view you have ever seen! Enjoy free time to explore this magnificent port. We say farewell to Tony today as we sail on to Olympia.



DAY 15 Friday, 2 October 2026 Olympia

This morning arrive into Katakolon and will enjoy a visit to Olympia, the site of the ancient Olympic Games. The Ancient Greeks flocked here every four years for more than a millennium to celebrate the sacred games dedicated to Zeus. We visit the ruins of the Sanctuary, with its athletic quadrangles, stadium, temples and treasures; then visit the modern Archaeological Museum, a treasure house of Archaic, Classical and Roman sculptures, including the famous Niki Winged Goddess of Victory.

DAY 16 Saturday, 3 October 2026 At Sea

General Information and Booking Conditions

International touring can involve a considerable amount of walking and stair climbing in the places visited and it is important that all tour participants have a level of physical fitness that allows them to take part in this activity without the need of assistance from others.

TOUR OPERATOR: Travelrite International Pty Ltd (ABN 64 005 817 078) is the tour organiser. Queen Victoria is operated by Cunard and the Queen Victoria fly/cruise arrangements are subject to the terms and conditions and general information detailed in the Cunard brochure 2025. All passengers must complete and sign a Travelrite International booking form.

TOUR COSTS: The tour costs are based on train, general transport and accommodation costs at 20 October 2025. Travelrite International reserves the right to alter the costs if any of these factors change, giving any passenger that has booked the right to withdraw with full refund of monies paid or modify arrangements. No alterations to price will be made within 90 days of departure from Australia.

DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT: A non-refundable deposit of \$1000 per passenger should be sent with a completed Travelrite International booking form that lists your requested cabin category. As soon as the booking is confirmed, (usually within 24 hours), a cruise confirmation advice will be posted to the client. The confirmation advice will contain all details. The passenger must also complete the Cunard online check in. Final payments are due to be paid to Travelrite International 90 days prior to the commencement of the Queen Victoria fly/cruise. A 1.5% administration fee will be added to payments made by credit card.
