

# DAY 1 Sunday October 12, 2025

### Houston

Depart Australia on your flight, arriving Houston same day.

Transfer to our hotel. *Overnight:* Fairfield Inn & Suites, Houston. ( - )

# DAY 2 Monday October 13, 2025

## Lafayette

Morning: After panoramic tour of Houston, Texas, travel to Lafayette & Breaux Bridge, Western Louisiana. Afternoon: Enjoy swamp tour, by boat. See amazing wildlife (alligators, turtles, birdlife) and distinctive swamp scenery. Evening: Commencement of tour dinner, including live music, at a Cajun restaurant or dance hall. Overnight: Double Tree by Hilton Lafayette. (B,D)

### **DAY 3** Tuesday October 14, 2025 New Orleans

Morning: Travel through beautiful western Louisiana swamp country, heading for New Orleans. On the way, visit Laura Plantation (antebellum homestead), including original slave quarters. Afternoon: Check into our hotel, in New Orleans' historic French Quarter, followed by free time. Evening: Explore the French Quarter, including colourful Bourbon Street. Youll find excellent jazz music in places like Fritzels Jazz Club and Preservation Hall (all optional). Overnight: Wyndham New Orleans — French Quarter. (B)



### **DAY 4** Wednesday October 15, 2025 **New Orleans**

Morning: Sightseeing coach tour of New Orleans with local guide, including visits to an above ground cemetery and areas ravaged by Hurricane Katrina (2005). Also, see the beautiful mansions in St Charles Ave. Afternoon: Free time. You may see outstanding street performers, Hack Bartholomew and Doreen Ketchens (the 'Clarinet Queen') performing in the French Quarter. Evening: Enjoy Mississippi River cruise, dinner & jazz music aboard a majestic Mississippi paddlewheeler. After the cruise, visit the Frenchmen Street area (excellent jazz music), with John Howie (optional). (B,D)

# **DAY 5** Thursday October 16, 2025 **Tupelo**

Travel to Tupelo, Mississippi, the town where Elvis Presley was born and raised. On the way, visit the excellent Jimmie Rodgers Museum, in Meridian, Mississippi. Jimmie Rodgers (1897-1933), known as The Singing Brakeman, was one of the first superstars of American country music. Next to the museum see the beautiful Dentzel Carousel, manufactured in 1896 for the 1904 St. Louis Exposition. Overnight: Hotel Tupelo. (B)

# **DAY 6** Friday October 17, 2025 Tupelo

Visit the Elvis Presley Birthplace Park, including Elvis's boyhood home, the church he attended as a boy, and the Elvis Presley Museum. Also, visit the hardware store where Elvis's mum bought him his first guitar, and see the schools he attended. *Evening:* Enjoy Craig Giles Rock 'n Roll Dinner & Show, including special Tribute to Elvis Presley. (B,D)



# **DAY 7** Saturday October 18, 2025 **Memphis**

Morning: Travel to Memphis, home of the blues and birthplace of rock 'n roll. Visit Graceland, Elvis Presley's famous mansion. Our Elvis Experience Tour tickets include tour of the mansion, plus various exhibits including his automobiles, wardrobe, gold records, custom planes, etc. Afternoon: Sightseeing coach tour of Memphis, before visiting the excellent Memphis Rock 'n Soul Museum or the Stax Museum of American Soul Music (you have a choice). Then check into our hotel. You may wish to view the famous Peabody Duck parade (approx. 4.30pm – 5pm), at the Peabody Hotel, across the road from our hotel. Evening: Visit Beale Street, where we take in the atmosphere of this colourful precinct, including live music venues such as B.B. Kings Blues Club & the Rum Boogie Café. Overnight: Holiday Inn Downtown Memphis. (B)

# **DAY 8** Sunday October 19, 2025 Memphis

Morning: Visit impressive Bass Pro camping/fishing/hunting superstore, in massive glass Pyramid-shaped building. Then attend colourful church service at Al Green's Full Gospel Tabernacle Church, including amazing gospel music. Afternoon: Guided tour of Sun Studio (famous 1950s recording studio, where Elvis, Johnny Cash, and others recorded). Also visit the National Civil Rights Museum (the motel — now museum — where



Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. was assassinated). *Evening:* Dinner at the excellent Majestic Grille Restaurant, followed by further exploration of the live music venues in Beale Street. (B,D)

# **DAY 9** Monday October 20, 2025 Branson

Travel through the state of Arkansas, and the picturesque Ozark Mountains, to Branson, Missouri. Branson is famous for its many live music theaters, some operated by entertainers like The Duttons, some featuring traditional country music/comedy shows, like the Baldknobbers Jamboree, and some featuring visiting country music stars like Gene Watson, Jimmy Fortune, & The Bellamy Brothers. On arrival enjoy a coach tour of Bransons Las Vegas-like main strip, featuring colourful electronic billboards, tourist attractions, music theaters, & hotels. Evening: Attend one of Branson's outstanding shows... The Duttons show. *Overnight*: The Dutton Inn. (B)

# **DAY 10** Tuesday October 21, 2025 Branson

Attend a morning show of your choice (optional). Afternoon: Free time. You may like to visit Old Branson Town (Branson's traditional shopping area). Evening: Attend Dolly Parton's Stampede (fabulous arena show, including dinner), featuring spectacular horse riding, buffalo and/or longhorn cattle, etc. (B,D)




# **DAY 11** Wednesday October 22, 2025 Branson

Today we visit Branson's Silver Dollar City Theme Park (where Australia's Wayne Horsburgh performed for many years). The park includes live music performances (aboveground) and spectacular limestone caves (underground). The annual Harvest Festival will be happening, featuring traditional craft demonstrations. Lots of excellent live music performances, on Silver Dollar City's many indoor & outdoor stages. Evening: Attend an outstanding Branson show of your choice. Note: Admission to the following attractions/shows in Branson is included in our tour: The Dutton Show; Dolly Parton Stampede dinner & show; Silver Dollar City theme park. Admission to other shows, in Branson, is optional; i.e, not included. (B)

# **DAY 12** Thursday October 23, 2025 Paducah

Depart Branson and travel to Paducah, Kentucky. On the way visit the fascinating, largely abandoned, town of Cairo, Illinois. Situated at the confluence of the Mississippi & Ohio rivers, Cairo was an important strategic town during the Civil War. In the 1920s the population was over 15,000. The population is now about 1,500. See many impressive buildings from a

# **DAY 13** Friday October 24, 2025 Nashville

Morning: Travel to Nashville, home of country music. On arrival, visit the Gaylord Opryland Resort & Convention Centre. This amazing hotel features a huge glass atrium and 9 acres of beautiful indoor gardens. Then visit the Opry Mills Shopping Mall (excellent shopping & food court [for lunch]). Afternoon: Sightseeing tour of Nashville, with local guide. Evening: Enjoy

fabulous live country music in Nashville's main entertainment precinct (around Broadway & 2nd Avenue). There are lots of great honky tonks (live music bars) in this area, plus the Wildhorse Saloon (large live music & line dancing venue). *Overnight*: Embassy Suites Nashville Vanderbilt. (B)

# **DAY 14** Saturday October 25, 2025 Nashville

Today we travel to the town of Lynchburg, Tennessee. Enjoy guided tour of Jack Daniel's Distillery, followed by lunch at Miss Mary Bobo's Boarding House & Restaurant (beautiful Southern home-cooked meals). *Evening:* Attend Nashville's famous Grand Ole Opry show, featuring country music's biggest stars. (B,L)



# **DAY 15** Sunday October 26, 2025 Nashville

Morning: Visit Nashville's outstanding Country Music Hall of Fame and the wonderful Ryman Auditorium (Grand Ole Opry venue 1943 – 1974). Afternoon: Travel to Hendersonville, on the outskirts of Nashville, where we visit Johnny Cash's grave. Then enjoy a performance (specially for our tour group) by the French Family Band. Late afternoon & evening: Back in Nashville, free time. You may wish to visit the Johnny Cash Museum, the Patsy Cline Museum, RCA Studio B, and excellent music venues like the Station Inn and the honky tonks (in Nashville's downtown area). All museums/venues optional, after our return from Hendersonville. (B, AfternoonTea)

### **DAY 16** Monday October 27, 2025 Departure

Morning: Free time for shopping and packing. Afternoon: Commence flights back to Australia, via Houston. (B)

**DAY 18** Wednesday October 29, 2025 Arrive in Australia

We arrive back in Australia and tour arrangements conclude.



# **DAY 1** Monday October 27, 2025 Washington D.C.

Morning: Fly to Washington D.C. Afternoon: Visit Lafayette Square, Washington D.C., where you will have an excellent view of The White House. Evening: Enjoy group dinner, before exploring D.C.'s live music venues (optional). Overnight: TBC (to be confirmed). (B,D)

# **DAY 2** Tuesday October 28, 2025 Washington D.C

Morning: Sightseeing coach tour of Washington D.C. with local guide. Visit Arlington National Cemetery (see President Kennedy's grave), the Lincoln Memorial, and the Vietnam Veterans Memorial. See the Washington Monument, the Capitol, the Pentagon, and many other famous landmarks. Afternoon: Free time. You may wish to join John Howie on a visit to some of the wonderful Smithsonian museums, including the Air and Space Museum & the National Museum of American History (see the original Star-Spangled Banner). Evening: Visit one of Washington D.C.'s interesting nightlife precincts; e.g., Georgetown; Adams Morgan; U Street, for some excellent live music (optional). (B)

### **DAY 3** Wednesday October 29, 2025 **Lancaster/Amish region**

Morning: Travel to Gettysburg, Pennsylvania. Enjoy a guided tour of Gettysburg National Military Park (site of Civil War's Battle of Gettysburg). Afternoon: Continue on to Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. This region is home to the 'Pennsylvania Dutch', including the Amish people, many of whom wear plain clothing and travel in horse-drawn buggies. On arrival we will visit the Bird-in-Hand Farmers Market, before checking in to our hotel. Evening: After dinner, enjoy a fun-filled music/singalong session, hosted by John Howie. Please bring your instruments & voices and join in! Overnight: Bird-in-Hand Family Inn. (B,D)

### **DAY 4** Thursday October 30, 2025 **New York**

Morning: Enjoy a coach tour of the Amish region, with local guide. Have lunch with an Amish farming family. After lunch continue on to New York. On arrival check into our hotel in central New York. Evening: Free time for you to explore the colourful area around our hotel, in central Manhattan (near Times Square & the Broadway theatre district). Overnight: Hotel Edison. (B,L)

### **DAY 5** Friday October 31, 2025 New York

Morning: Sightseeing coach tour of New York, with local guide. Visit Midtown area, Central Park, Harlem, Wall Street financial district, and 9/11 Memorial. Afternoon (mid-afternoon onwards):





Free time. Evening: Free time for you to explore New York's diverse restaurants and live music venues (optional). John Howie will offer suggestions re. live music venues. (B)

### **DAY 6** Saturday November 1, 2025 New York

Morning: Enjoy a cruise on New York Harbor, aboard the famous Staten Island Ferry. See the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island (historic immigrant processing facility). Then go for a walk on the Brooklyn Bridge (great views of the N.Y. skyline from the bridge). Afternoon: Free time. You may like to spend time in New York's colourful Greenwich Village precinct. Morning: Free time for shopping and packing. Mid-day approx.:

Transfer to airport. Commence flights back to Australia. (B)

The tour's costs are based on transport, accommodation costs and entrance costs at 10 October 2024. Travelrite reserves the right to alter the costs if any of these factors change, giving any passenger that has booked the right to withdraw with full refund of monies paid or modify arrangements. No alterations to costings will be made within 60 days prior to departure.

**DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS.** A deposit of \$500 per passenger is required at the time of booking. Full payment will be required 60 days prior to departure. A 1% administration charge will be added to payment by Visa and Mastercard. 3% administration charge will be added for payment by AMEX and Diners.
